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ENTRANCE AND EXIT REQUIREMENTS

Entrance:

1. Applications for grades K-5 in the International Studies Elementary Charter School will be taken continuously and applicants will be notified as slots become available. Each year new applicants will be notified in the spring.
2. In order to be eligible for admission, parents must complete an application.
3. During open enrollment, applications for grades K-5 will be given equal consideration. The students who reside in the "traditional" attendance zone for ISECS will be given priority.
4. If an older sibling is currently in the charter school program (grades K-5), the sibling entering kindergarten will be afforded family preference for the upcoming year.
5. When a slot becomes available, a letter is sent to the applicant in the event that he/she cannot be reached by phone. It is the responsibility of the applicant to inform ISECS of any change of address or number change. From the day of notification, the applicant has 24 hours to either accept or reject the available slot.
6. Applicants contacted by phone about slot availability, have 24 hours to render a decision.
7. If an applicant declines the position offered and asks to be re-activated, the person must fill out a new application. The declined applications are withdrawn from the active file. At this time, the new application is stapled to the old application, a new number is issued, and the application is placed in the active file again.
8. Final admission to the school is based on being promoted to the grade for which the student has applied. In the event a parent is notified of a position available for his/her child on the current grade level waiting list, and the parent indicates that the child did not meet promotion requirements in the present school setting, the position is automatically denied and the application is withdrawn.

***** Once applicants have been accepted they must successfully complete one semester before considering withdrawal. *****

Exit

Withdrawal may occur for one or more of the following reasons:

- Parents' lack of interest in the instructional focus at ISECS
- Continued serious breeches of acceptable behavior
- Desire to return to the regularly zoned school
- Moving out of the Dougherty County School System
